<u>Treasurer's Report - Al Ashley</u>

- See Al's report for details
- About \$500 less in the bank than at this time last year
- Expenses were slightly less than revenues for 2024; biggest annual expenses include speaker honorariums and room rentals
- 276 members most ever (246 last year); 56 new members in 2024; 6 new members so far this year; 3 honorary members are shop teachers
- 74% of members have renewed so far versus 79% last year
- Al will reach out to members who haven't renewed yet; cutoff is Feb. 4 meeting so may reduce roster
- Board members authorized to sign checks will remain the same
- Al will step down as Treasurer after 2025, so club will begin recruiting new Treasurer

Education - Andrew Pellar

- Has an admin assistant, possible committee members, club members who have expressed interest in being teacher's assistants
- Looking into a new class format to discuss specific projects, such as projects brought to Bring & Brag or shared on email chat; will be organized via email chat, interested members will respond directly to host
 - o Andrew will talk to Tony to ensure it won't add more work for him
- More classes in the works, including project-based classes
